£275 – HE Cake Club - the Baking Club has been such a success that money was needed for expansion.



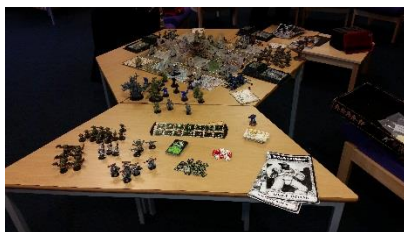
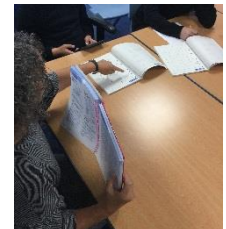
£299 – PE bid for a portable Cube Projector which allows performances and skills to be recorded allowing for instantaneous playback to the students.



£470 – Photography - Higher Photography required extra lenses to supplement the standard ones, in particular a zoom lens.

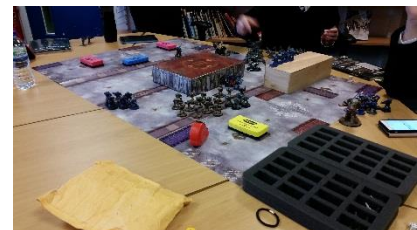


£282 - Support for Learning - numeracy support resources were purchased to develop a nurture class for numeracy support for some of our S1 pupils.



£140 – Library – asked for resource to start a Warhammer club in the library, an extracurricular activity. Warhammer has 40,000 links with Art and CDT, and English and Maths. There is the opportunity at a future date to

play schools from across the UK through the Warhammer School Alliance. The School Alliance is also registered with the Duke of Edinburgh Award as an approved activity for the skills section and can be used towards the bronze, silver or gold.



£820 - Geography & RMPS - funding to subsidise a visit from Zoolab for our S2 pupils, DVD resources and an Apple TV. The 2 educational DVDs have already been integrated into the S2 course. The Rainforest and Coasts units. Zoolab are an excellent company who visit us to show us animals that live in the rainforest as part of our unit. It is hands on and the pupils really enjoy it.

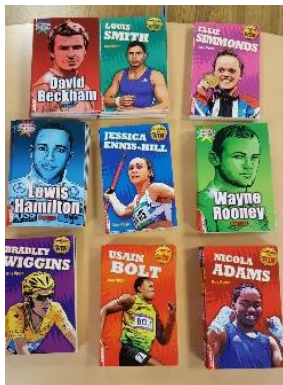


Successful Fund Raising 2017/8



£150 - Fair Trade Group - our new Fairtrade group bid for money to get them started up a Fairtrade tuck shop, holding stalls at parents' evenings and having coffee mornings as well as inviting guest speakers.

£126 - Media – bid for additional filmmaking equipment for the production aspect of National 5 and Higher Media- 32Gb Rode Boom pole 2 metre 2 section @ £34.80 and 3x Boom poles @ total of £104.49 and 2x SD Cards @ total of £21.38



£282 - Literacy bid for Sporting Stars Graphic Novels to support our reading initiatives.
